**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$21,500 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$10,000 FROM DISTRICTS 2 AND 3; \$1,000 FROM DISTRICT 4; AND \$500 FROM DISTRICT 6; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO THE LINCOLN FOUNDATION FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE WHITNEY M. YOUNG SCHOLARS PROGRAM.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The sum of \$21,500 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$10,000 from Districts 2 and 3; \$1,000 from District 4; and \$500 from District 6; through the Office of Management and Budget, to the Lincoln Foundation for costs associated with the Whitney M. Young Scholars Program

**SECTION II:** The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

**SECTION III:** This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

**SECTION IV:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
