Dear Councilman Mulvihill –

We appreciate your support in sponsoring the Brightside located on Indian Trail at Newburg Road. We would like to discuss another Brightside in your district. This site is located on Bardstown Road at I-264 (the site closest to Rally's). Currently the site is not sponsored. We would like to see if you have an interest in sponsoring this site as well. The cost of sponsorship is \$4,250 for FY21.

The sponsorship includes:

- Monitor and assess site needs regularly
- Apply hardwood mulch and reapply as necessary
- Trim all shrubs couple of times throughout the growing season
- Remove weeds at site on a regular basis
- Water site during times of drought, as needed
- Apply herbicides and pesticides, as needed
- Apply Woodace 14-14-14 fertilizer, as needed
- Maintain sponsor sign
- Remove debris from curbs and bed area on a bi-weekly basis
- Mow and string trim turf area bi-weekly from April-October

Please let us know if you are interested in sponsorship by Friday, October 16<sup>th</sup>. If we can not find a sponsor for this site, we will turn it back over to the state and remove the Brightside sign. The state might remove all plant material and turn the site into turf only.
