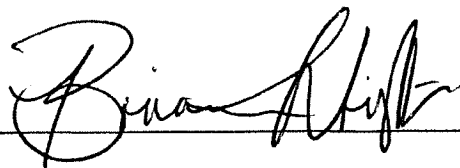

**Total = \$7,685.00**

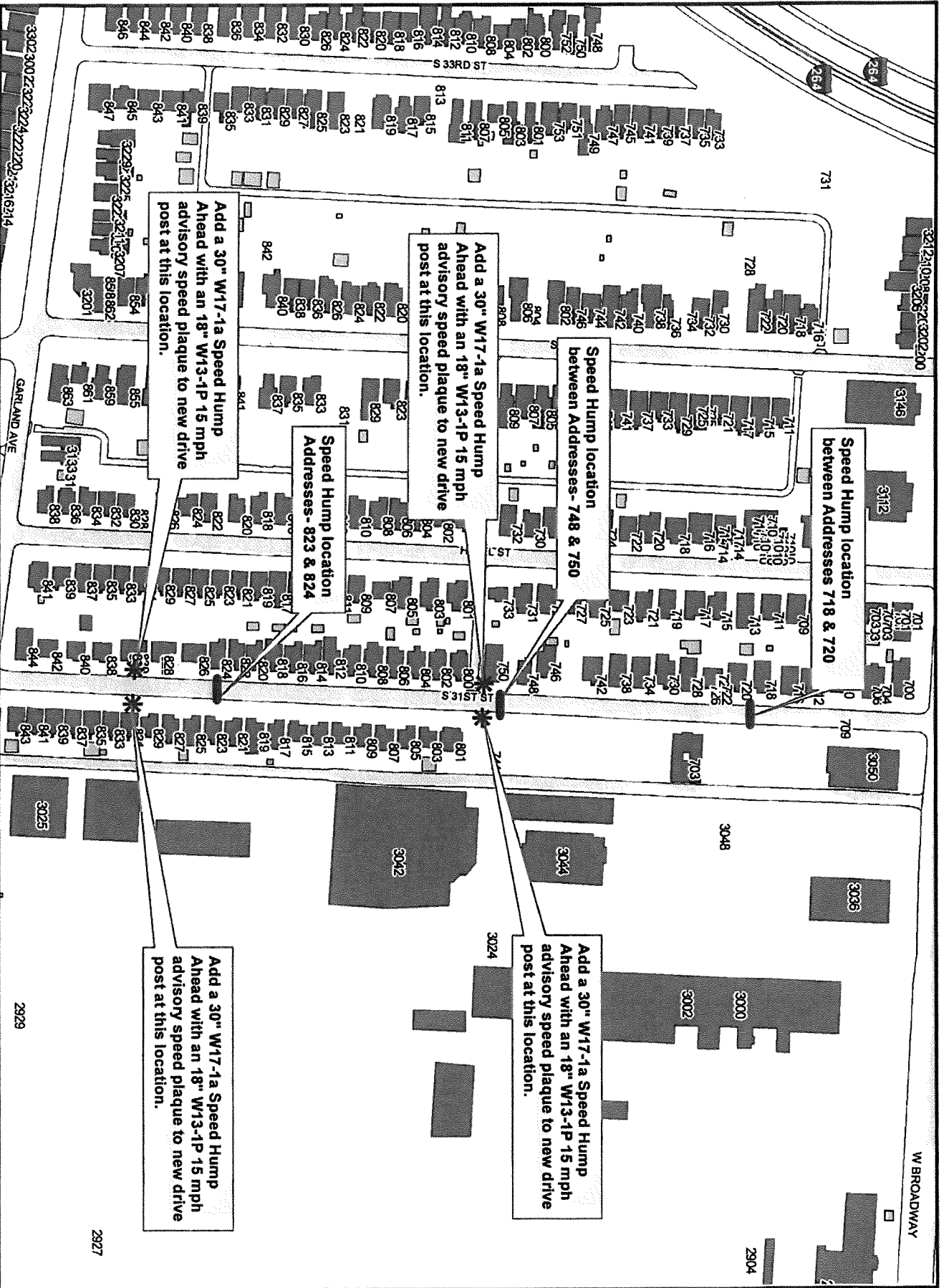
Please consider this letter as our official Statement of Cost for all speed hump related work. Each speed hump, including markings is \$2,215.00 and each sign is \$260.00. Based on our Engineering Studies, a total of three (3) speed humps and four (4) speed hump signs have been proposed for S. 31<sup>st</sup> Street, between Broadway and Garland Avenue. The total "not to exceed" cost is \$7,685.00.

Upon funding approval, the speed humps will be installed as schedule and weather permits.
