Louisville Metro placed #11 in the Nation during the 2014 NNO event. We will be participating once again and our goal continues (with the Council Members help) to be #1 in the Nation for 2015.

Our tentative theme this year is-“Commit to get fit.” Our goal is to get the youth active, off their couches and away from the television and gaming systems in an effort to have them learn to live a healthier lifestyle.
