

	c) 4 shall be professionally involved in visual arts in Louisville.
	Up to 4 additional members must meet one of the requirements of a), b), or c) above. If an appointment is made under a) above, an appointment under c) above must also be made.

TERM OF APPOINTMENT	4 years or until their successor is appointed.
	Citizen members may be appointed for one succeeding term, except that members originally appointed to fill an unexpired term may be appointed for a second succeeding term. No member may serve for more than two full terms.

QUORUM	A majority of membership of COPA shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The affirmative vote of a majority of the members present at a meeting shall be necessary for the adoption of any motion, measure or resolution.
