**Total = \$6,300.00**

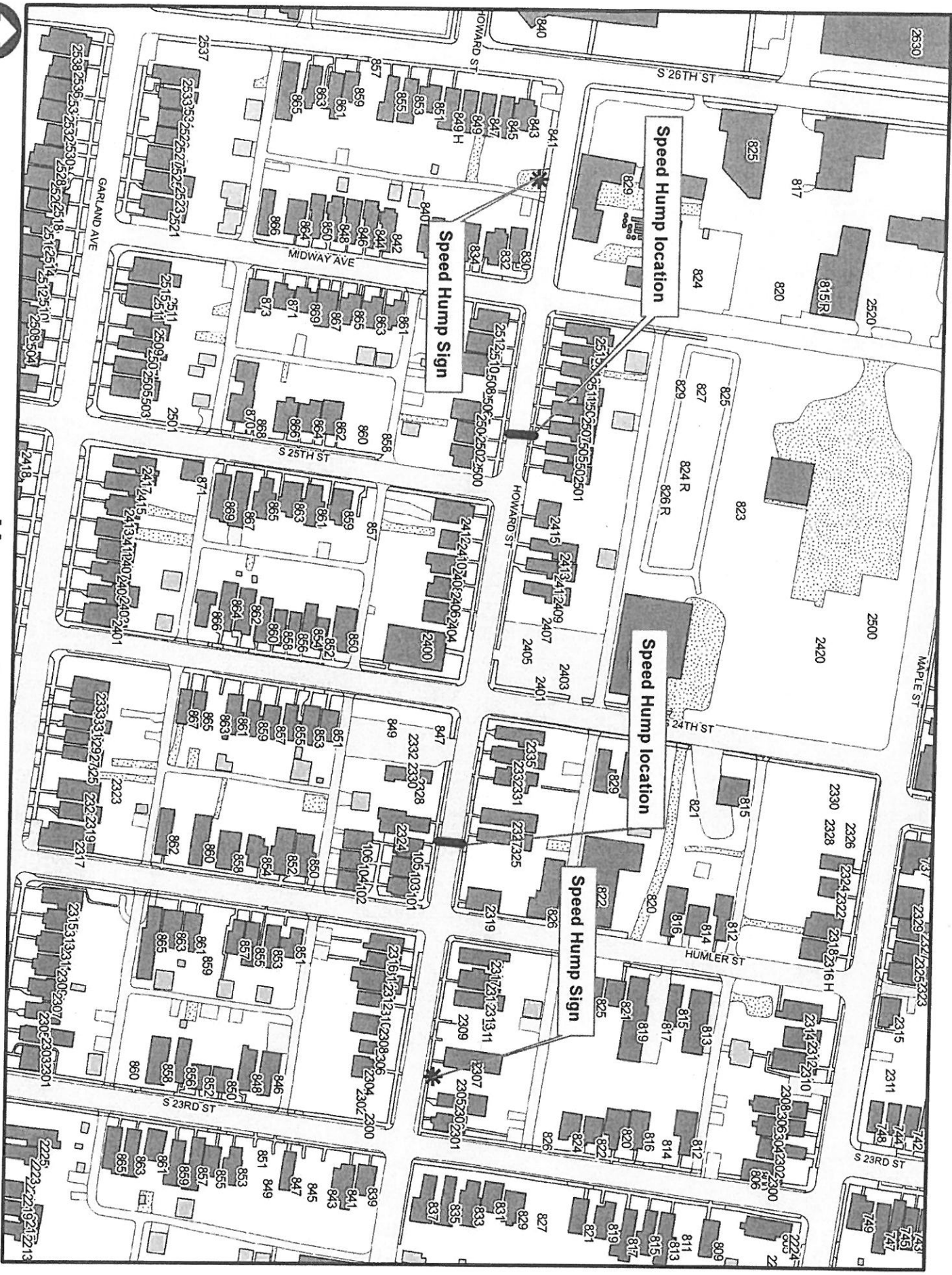

Based on our Engineering Studies, a total of two (2) speed humps and two (2) speed hump signs have been proposed for Howard Street, between S. 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and S. 26<sup>th</sup> Street. The total "not to exceed" cost is \$6,300.00, and as I understand it, you have offered to fund the entire amount.
