Please consider this letter as our official Statement of Cost for all speed hump related work. Each speed hump, including markings is \$2,050.00 and each sign is \$260.00. Based on our Engineering Studies, a total of seven (7) speed humps and six (6) speed hump signs have been proposed for Hunters Point Circle, between Weber Lane and Mount Holy Yoke Drive. The total "not to exceed" cost is **\$15,910.00**.

As I understand it, the cost will be split between your office and the HOA. Please see breakdown of cost below:

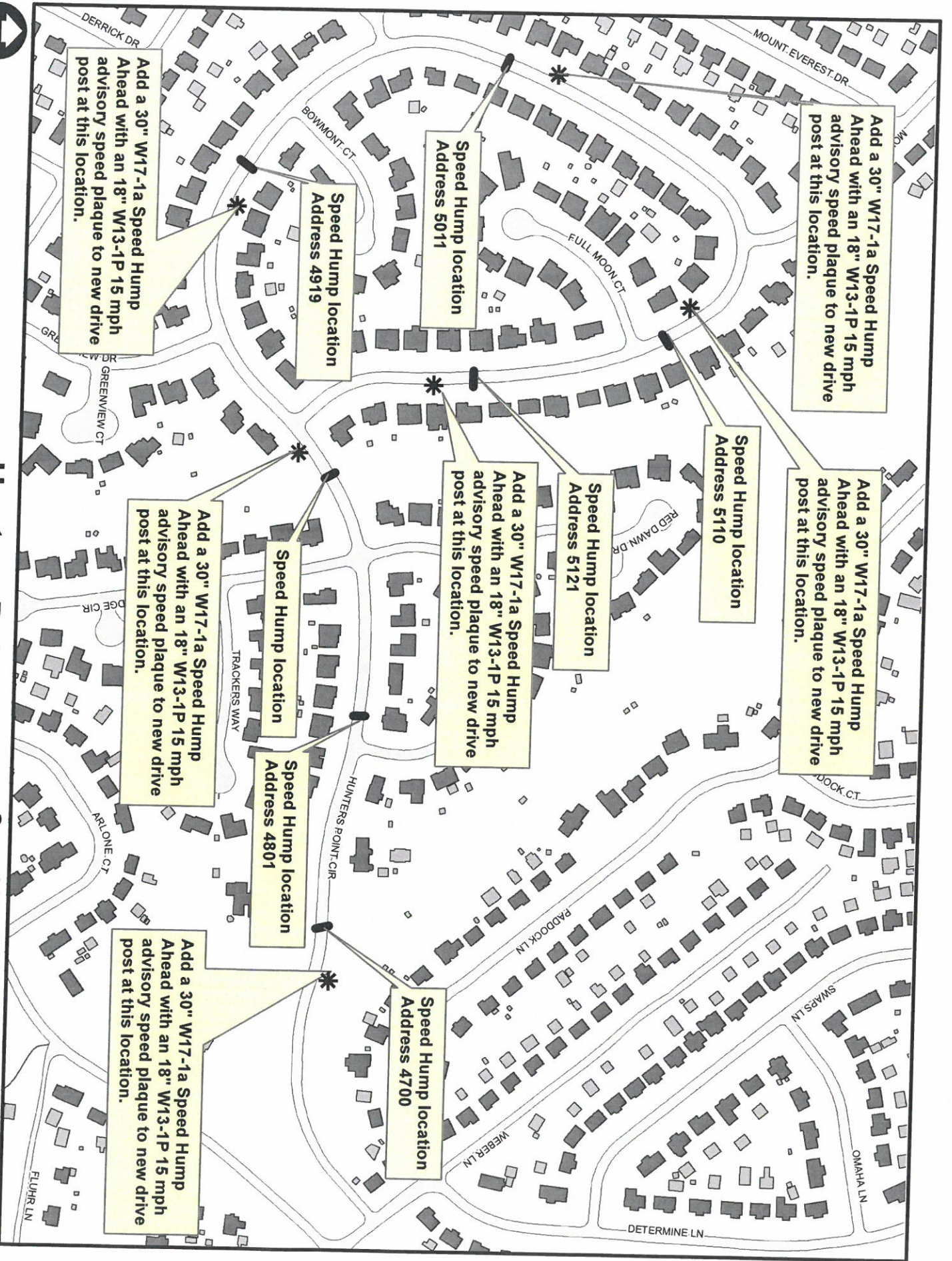
District 12 cost- **\$7,955.00**
