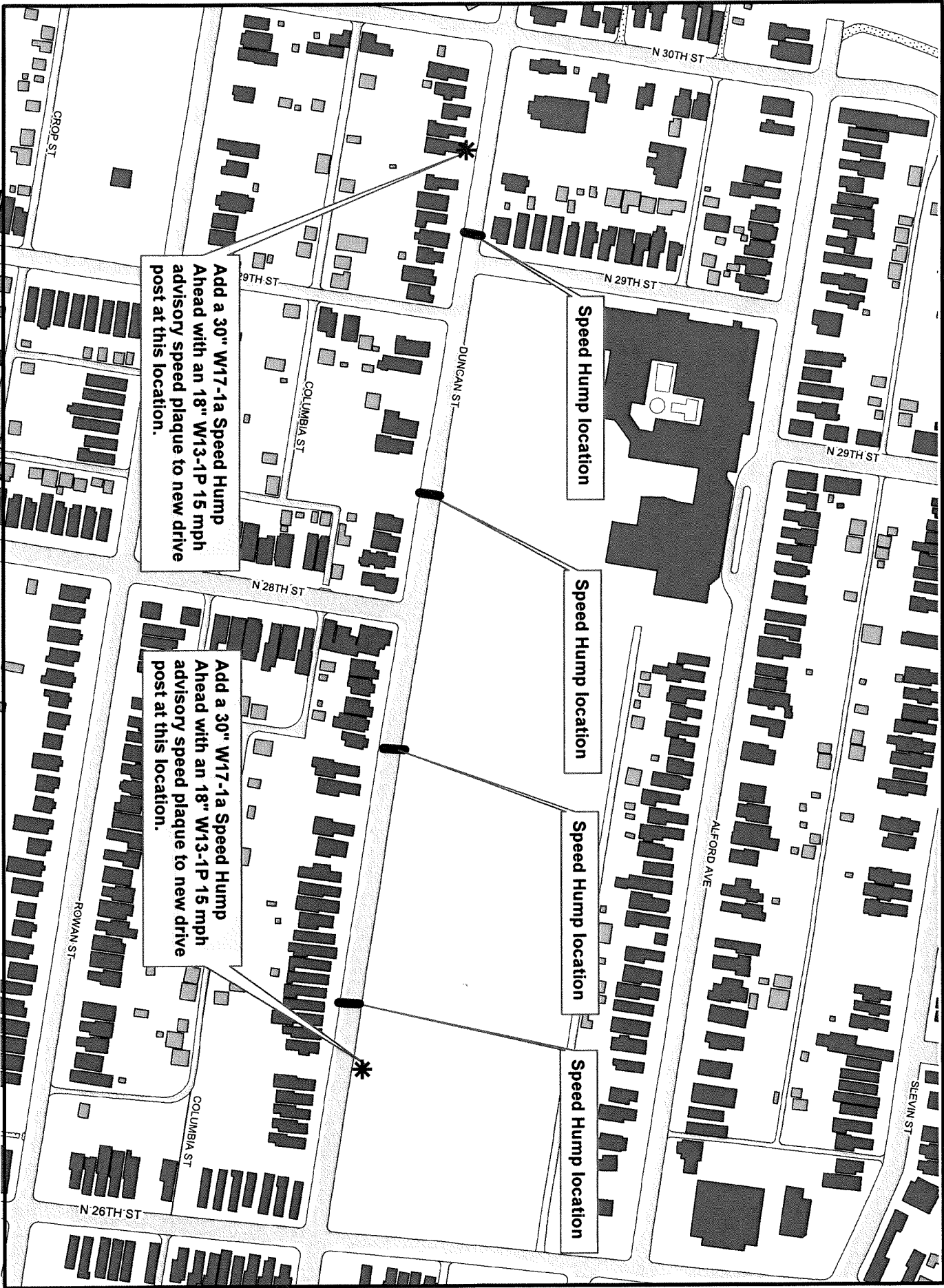

Total = \$11,720.00

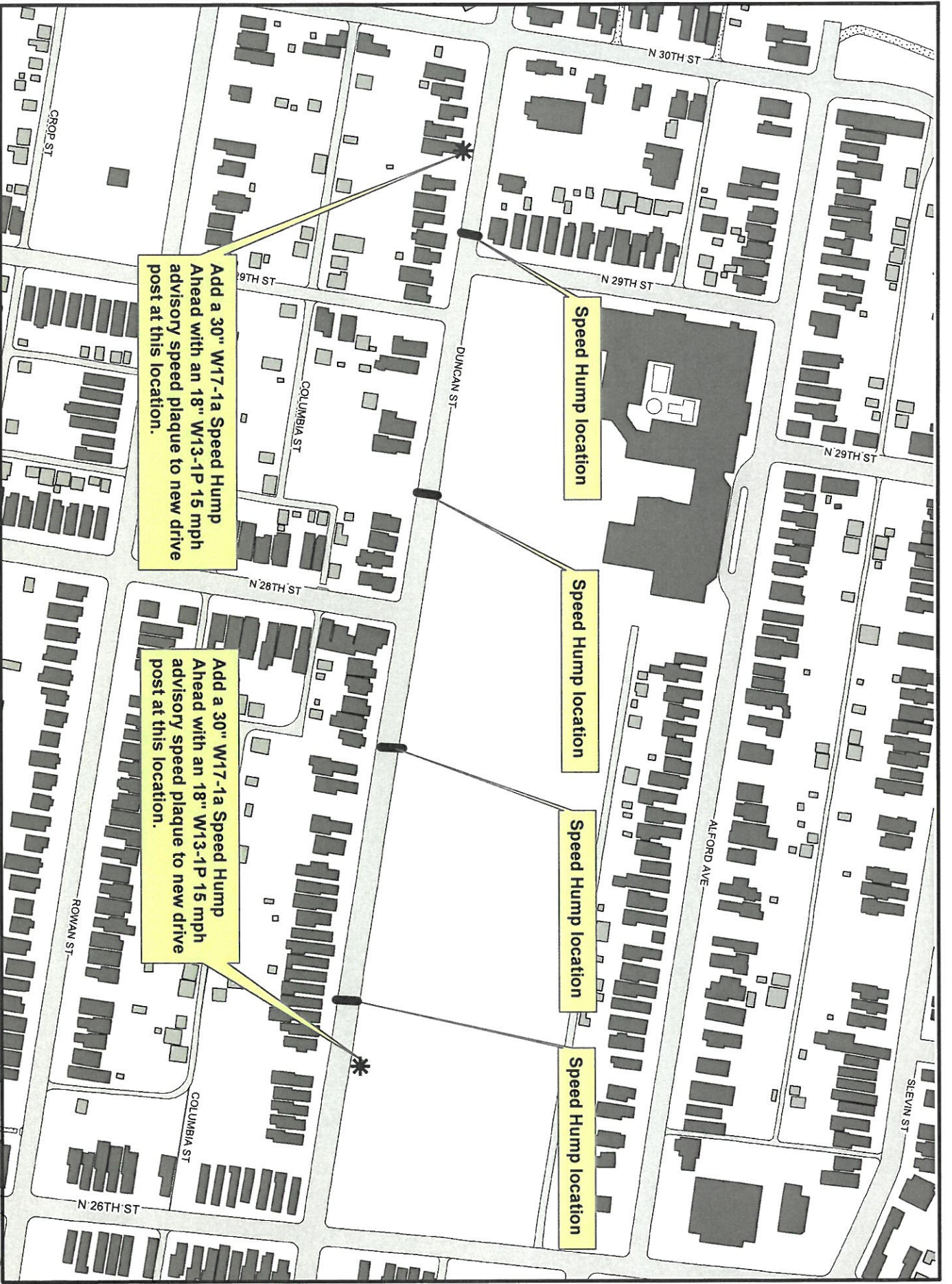
Please consider this letter as our official Statement of Cost for all speed hump related work. Each speed hump, including markings is \$2,800.00 and each sign is \$260.00. Based on our Engineering Studies, a total of four (4) speed humps and two (2) speed hump signs have been proposed for Duncan Street, between N. 26th Street and N. 30th Street. The total "not to exceed" cost is **\$11,720.00**.

Upon funding approval, the speed humps will be installed as weather permits.
