It will be this sign just with LED lights strobing around the perimeter.

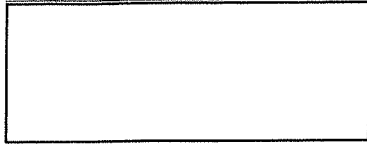
