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

Dear Dante:

We are herewith requesting Relief from LDC Section 4.2.35.G to allow the proposed multi-story, climate-controlled, self-storage, mini-warehouse facility to be more than 1 story. This CUP regulation contemplates 1-story mini-warehouse type buildings, whereas this proposal is for multi-story office building looking structures. Thus the height limitation of the CUP regulation will never apply to this kind of multi-story, climate-controlled self-storage development. The overall site design with enhanced landscaping will mitigate this CUP modification requests.
