CM Coan,

Louisville Metro Traffic Engineering has determined, based on field conditions, the above listed intersections will be best converted to a permanent all way stop condition with signs posted in the roadway. In order to do this we propose the installation of (6) delineator posts on each mainline approach (4 total). This work will be done by our contractor and cost approximately \$4,224. Because this is above and beyond anything LMPW has the resources to complete we are hoping you are willing to fund this component of the conversion. Please let us know if you have any questions or if you would like to discuss this matter further. If you are in support of the project please forward us the resolution and cost center information so we can request a PO to schedule this project and the subsequent permanent stop signage installation.
