I reached out to Craig Allen Louisville Metro Public Works Sidewalk Engineer. He informed me that the section of sidewalk at 6016 Mercury Drive was reported in October of 2018 and was placed on Public Work's 3 year sidewalk paving schedule. It is currently slated for repair in 2022. After learning that the sidewalk was rated as a five, for severe, Councilman Engel has asked Craig Allen to provide our office with an updated cost estimate for repair. He will then look into pulling money from CIF funds to get the sidewalk repaired this summer.
