

ORDINANCE NO. 020, SERIES 2019

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ~~\$13,750~~\$18,250 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$8,000 FROM DISTRICT 14; \$2,000 FROM DISTRICT 9; \$1,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 1, ~~AND~~13, 15, AND 24; \$500 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 2, 3, 4, 7, 10, 12, AND 21; \$250 FROM DISTRICTS 8, 11, AND 19; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO LOUISVILLE ASSET BUILDING COALITION, INC. FOR OPERATING EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH COORDINATING THE VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (VITA) (AS AMENDED).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of ~~\$13,750~~\$18,250 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$8,000 from District 14; \$2,000 from District 9; \$1,000 each from Districts 1, ~~and~~13, 15, and 24; \$500 each from Districts 2, 3, 4, 7, 10, 12, and 21; \$250 from Districts 8, 11, and 19; through the Office of Management and Budget, to Louisville Asset Building Coalition, Inc. for operating expenses associated with coordinating the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program (VITA).


SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.



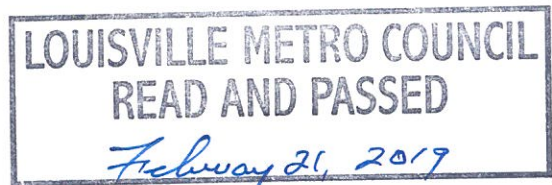
