ORDINANCE NO. 033, SERIES 2023

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ~~\$9,500~~ ~~\$10,500~~ \$14,500 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$5,000 FROM DISTRICT 12; \$3,000 FROM DISTRICT 14; \$1,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 8, 10, AND 24, AND 25; AND \$500 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 9 AND 16; AND \$250 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 1, 3, 5, 15, 17, AND 21, TO METRO PARKS FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE 10TH ANNUAL RIVERVIEW INDEPENDENCE FESTIVAL (AS AMENDED).


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE "COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of ~~\$9,500~~ ~~\$10,500~~ \$14,500 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$5,000 from District 12; \$3,000 from District 14; \$1,000 each from Districts 8, 10, and 24, and 25; and \$500 each from Districts 9 and 16; and \$250 each from Districts 1, 3, 5, 15, 17, and 21, to Metro Parks for costs associated with the 10th Annual Riverview Independence Festival.


SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.
