Please consider this letter as our official Statement of Cost for all speed hump related work. Each speed hump, including markings is \$2,150.00. Based on our Engineering Studies, a total of four (4) speed humps have been proposed for Oleanda Avenue, between 7th Street and Taylor Blvd. The total "not to exceed" cost is **\$8,600.00**.

As I understand it, the Districts have agreed to split the total cost three ways, which equals out to **\$2,866.67** per District.

Upon funding approval, the speed humps will be installed as weather permits.
