

Monday January 30<sup>th</sup> 1899

Court met re  
Present, Hon James P. Gregory, Judge

One instrument of writing purporting to be the last will and testament of Anna Maria Stahl, deceased, late of this County, was produced in Court and proved by the testimony of Anton Leisman one of the subscribing witnesses thereto, who also proved the testimony of W. H. Rademaker the other subscribing witness thereto; whereupon the same was established by the Court to be the last will and testament of said testatrix and ordered to be recorded.

This day came Anton Stahl the Executor named in the last will and testament of Anna Maria Stahl, deceased, late of this County, who made oath according to law; execution of said will is granted him, whereupon he executed bond as required by law, without surety, as requested in said will, which said bond is duly stamped as required by act of Congress.

This day came B. C. Hubbard and produced and filed in Court his commission from the Governor of this Commonwealth appointing him a Notary Public in and for Jefferson County; his commission bears date November 20<sup>th</sup> 1898 and expires at the end of the next Session of Senate, whereupon he took the oath and executed bond as required by law, with C. Kellogg as his surety, which said bond is duly stamped as required by act of Congress.

The Court grants unto Geo. W. Hummel, a duly authorized Minister of the Gospel and license to solemnize the rites of matrimony, whereupon he took the oath and executed bond as required by law, with C. R. Crow as his surety, which said bond is duly stamped as required by act of Congress.

This day came Sarah J. Moore as minor child of C. B. Moore, and over fourteen years of age, personally into Court and chose The Louisville Trust Co as her guardian, which was appointed accordingly.

On motion of Edward Reider, father of the infant Edward Reider, and fourteen years of age, the Court appoints The Louisville Trust Co guardian of said infant Edward Reider.

On motion of Ernoch, mother of the infant Daniel Ernoch, under fourteen years of age and orphan of Henry Ernoch, the Court appoints The Louisville Trust Co guardian of said infant Daniel Ernoch.

Came assigned Doris Block by Counsel Attorney and filed his state-  
ment herein

In re - estate of Dunlop - Robert Dunlop Co assigned

On motion of assignee and assignor herein by Counsel at the order  
ordered by the Court that John C. Beck be and is appointed appraiser herein in lieu  
of Charles Claggett, therefore came said John C. Beck and took the oath required by  
law and such appraiser appointed

Ordered that Dennis J. Coleman, William Lynch, and John Potholme or any two  
of them after being first duly sworn do appraise the personal estate of Frances  
Emswiffe, deceased, and report to Court

In re - Assessment of E. C. Gregory

This day came Robert E. Woods, Revenue Agent for Jefferson County, Ky,  
and suggested to the Court that the hereinafter described land had been omitted  
from assessments for State and County purposes for the year 1890

Then came Jas. H. Ray acting James American, father of the owner of said land  
and submitted to the Court the liability thereof for assessment for said year and  
the assessable value thereof and the Court being advised adjudged that said land is  
liable for assessment for said year and fixed the fair cash value thereof at \$1100.<sup>00</sup>

This day came J. Gumm and filed herein an agreement signed by John  
Grove, H. L. Grove, J. J. Blankenshater, L. A. Blankenshater, Alice Gumm, George Grove,

 and be dedicated, on condition that the petitioners and applicants for said road  
 pay the costs of this procedure and the costs of opening said road and putting the  
 same in condition for travel. J. S. Green is hereby authorized, on behalf of the petitioners,  
 to open said roadway, as dedicated, but his compensation, if any, shall be paid  
 by the petitioners.

On the matter of the last will and testament of Sarah Gibbons Dealing deceased.

For motion of John S. Seiler the Executor nominated in the will of said Sarah Gibbons  
 produced in Court and purporting to be the last will and testament of Sarah Gibbons  
 deceased, by her Counsel Wm. Ware, and it appearing to the Court that Sarah Gibbons was one of  
 the subscribing witnesses to said will, and it being proved at Clark County, Ill.  
 It is therefore ordered by the Court that a commission issue to take the deposition  
 of said witness.

The Court consents to the transfer of State License No 890 from D. D. Connell to  
 John Felder, authorizing him to retail Spite Vinous and Malt Liquor at the  
 location named therein until the expiration thereof.

Ordered that Court stands adjourned until to-morrow morning at 10 O'clock
