

WATERFRONT REVIEW OVERLAY DISTRICT**PERMIT**

In accordance with Chapter 162 of the Louisville Metro Government Ordinances, the proposed design changes to property located at 388 E. Witherspoon St have been determined to comply with applicable Waterfront Review Overlay design guidelines, Waterfront Development Corporation standards, and applicable portions of the Louisville Waterfront Master Plan dated 1991. This applicant proposes install two signs at the aforementioned parking lot location, one at each of the two parking lot entrances.

The permit expires in 6 months from the date issued, unless substantial construction has begun. Construction/ demolition must be complete within 6 months of permit issuance.

Should design details change, a permit modification approval letter is required to prevent this permit from automatically expiring.

The applicant is hereby authorized to seek a building permit from Louisville Metro government, provided regulatory requirements, outside the Waterfront design review process, have been met.
