To whom it may concern:

At the request of the Okolona Fire Protection District, the Louisville Metro Planning Commission has initiated the process of changing the name of Crandon Road. Crandon Road is a short section of street, as shown on the enclosed exhibit, which becomes Standiford Plaza Drive at its northern end without an intersection or other indication of the name change. In the interests of public safety, so that emergency responders can quickly determine the location of a reported emergency, the stretch of road from Antle Drive to Hasbrook Drive should have a single name. Standiford Plaza Drive is the name of the longer section of roadway, and so it is proposed to change the name of Crandon Road to Standiford Plaza Drive.

As the owner of a property that adjoins the roadway between Antle Drive and Hasbrook Drive, you may be affected by the proposed name change. Consequently, we are reaching out to you to solicit any feedback you may have on this proposal. Please contact me by January 15, 2019 to let me know of any questions or concerns you may have.
