

The 4th Division will once again be hosting our annual National Night Out event on Tuesday, August 1st 2017 from 5-8pm in Wyandotte Park. I would like to request money from the following Council members who encompass the 4th Division Boundaries, for the National Night Out Against Crime. Louisville Metro continues to have a national ranking with the NNO (National Night Out) event. We will once again be participating and our goal continues (with the Council Members help) to be #1 in the Nation for 2017.

The Louisville Metro Police Department is committed to Mayor Fischer's goal of making Louisville, America's safest and most compassionate city. Our tentative theme is "Unity Through Community."
