Term of Appointment Details

4 years or until their successor is appointed. May be appointed for one succeeding term. ½ of initial citizen appointees shall serve for a 2 year term and thereafter will serve a 4 year term. Ex officio members appointment is coterminous with their office or position.

Vacancy Appointment Details

Mayor appoints a person to serve for the unexpired term.

Quorum

A majority of membership of COPA shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The affirmative vote of a majority of the members present at a meeting shall be necessary for the adoption of any motion, measure or resolution.

7 citizens appointed by the Mayor with Council approval

Qualification of Members

7 citizen members appointed by Mayor with Council approval: 2 shall be a civic/business leader in Louisville; 1 shall be faculty member of the art department of a university or college in Louisville; 4 shall be professionally involved in visual arts in Louisville.
