Liz,
To upgrade the old open bottom light to an LED would be \$7.37/month for 5 years, so you would need to appropriate \$442.20. We would recommend the 250W LED equivalent to replace the 175W MV.

To add a new 250Weq LED light on an existing pole would be about \$11.36/month and you would need to fund for at least 5 years for a total of \$681.60. After 5 years, if no additional funds are appropriated, the light would be turned off.
