Our theme this year is- “Commit to get Fit.” Our goal is to get our youth off the couch, away from the television and gaming systems and commit to a healthier lifestyle. Police Officers will be in different stations with basketballs, footballs, soccer field, tennis etc to interact with our youth. We will purchase Jump Ropes, Hula Hoops, Water Bottles, Pedometers, Frisbees, Basketballs, Footballs and other fitness items to achieve our goal. We had 5,000 community members attend our 2013 event.
