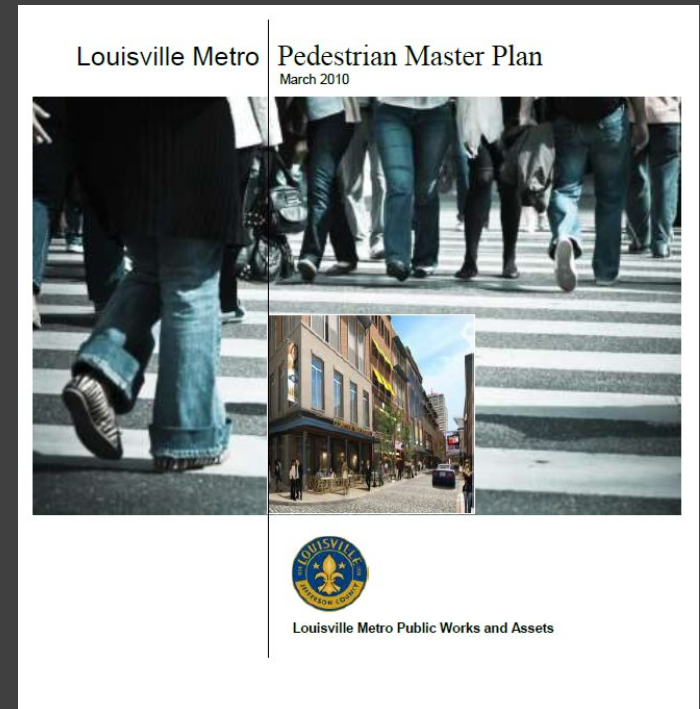
# Pedestrian Master Plan

## **Vision:**

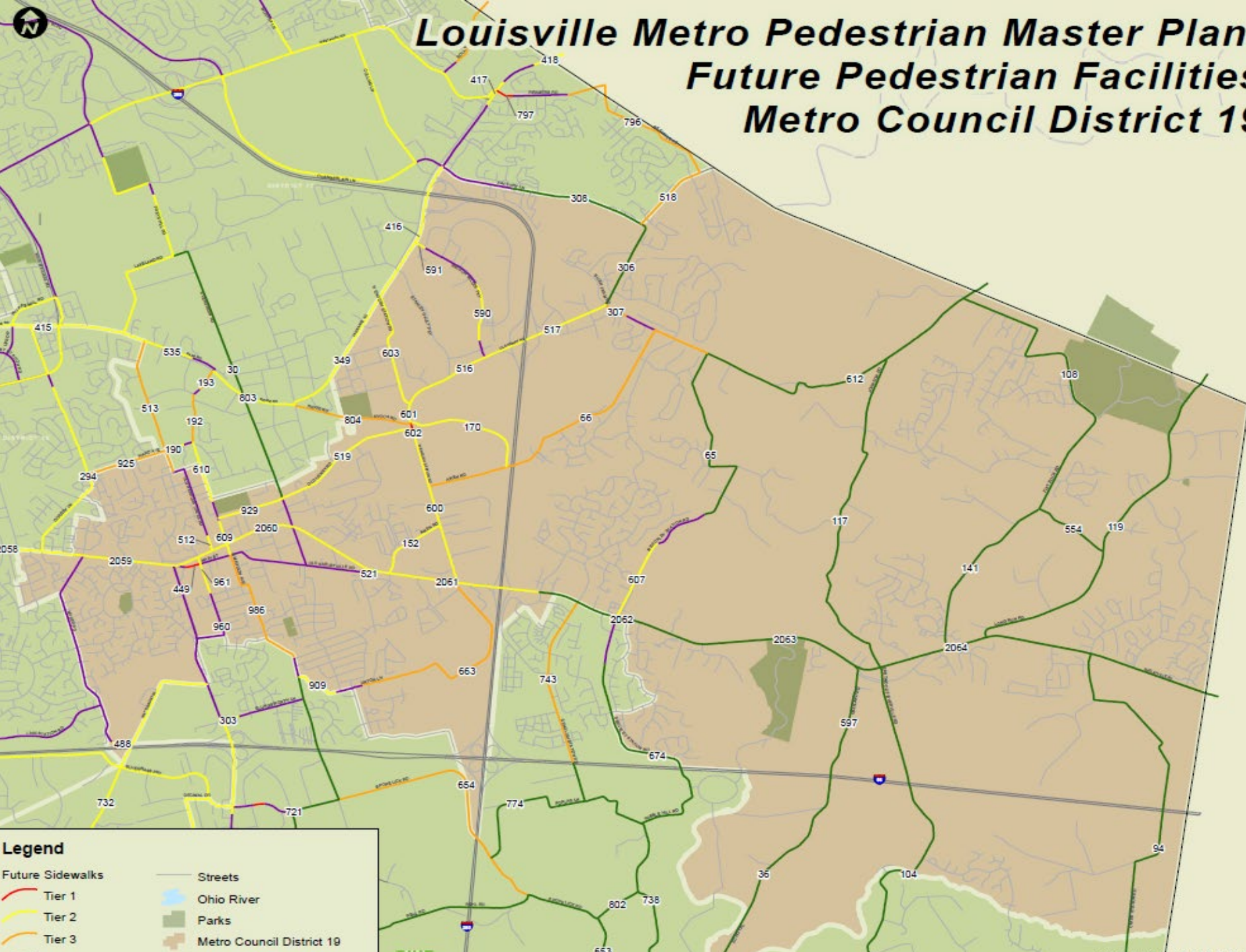
**For Louisville to become the safest and most appealing community for pedestrians!**

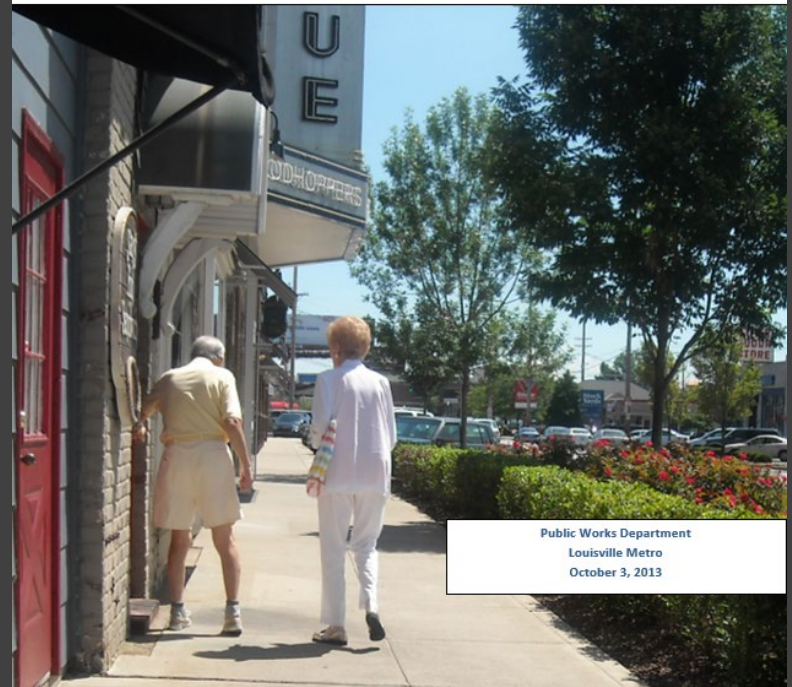




# Understanding Pedestrian Crashes

Of all the fatalities occurring on Metro roadways, 26% are pedestrian fatalities. In 2013, Metro conducted a 5-year pedestrian crash analysis (2006-2010) to identify trends, high risk populations and high crash locations to target efforts to reduce pedestrian injuries and fatalities.

# Move Louisville
