Two (2) Speed Humps x \$2,050.00 = \$4,100.00
Two (2) Speed Hump signs x \$260.00 = \$520.00
Total = \$4,620.00

Please consider this letter as our official Statement of Cost for all speed hump related work. Each speed hump, including markings is \$2,050.00 and each sign is \$260.00. Based on our Engineering Studies, a total of two (2) speed humps and two (2) speed hump signs have been proposed for Anna Lane, between Cloverleaf Drive and Yolanda Drive. The total "not to exceed" cost is \$4,620.00.

As I understand it, District 15 and the Cloverleaf HOA has agreed to split the cost: your cost will be **\$2,310.00** and the HOA will fund the remaining cost of ~~\$2,310.00~~.

Upon receipt of payment, the speed humps and signage will be installed as schedule and weather permits.
