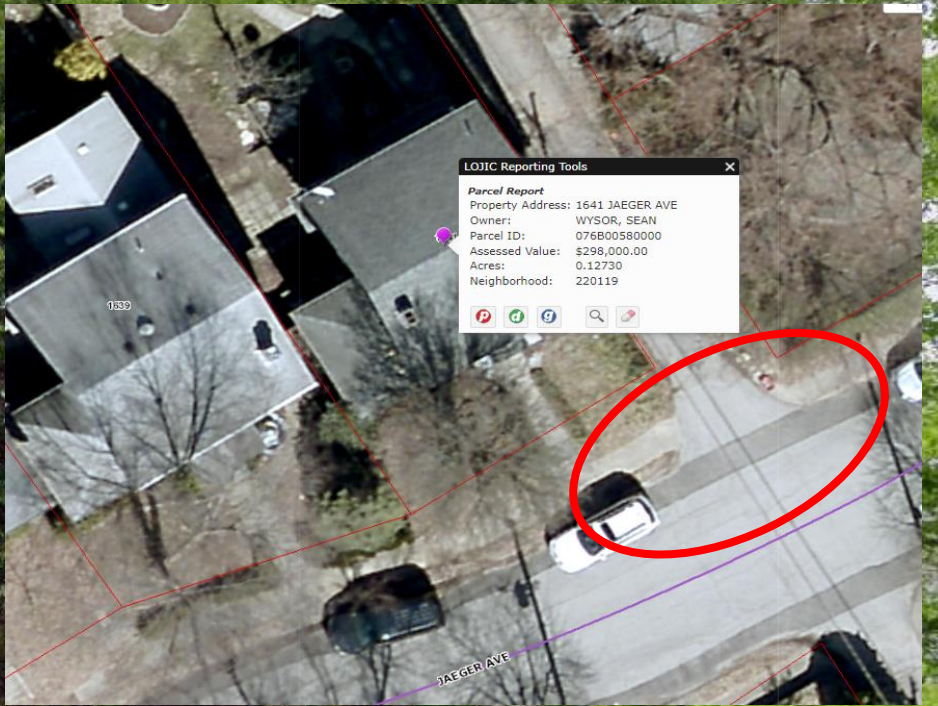

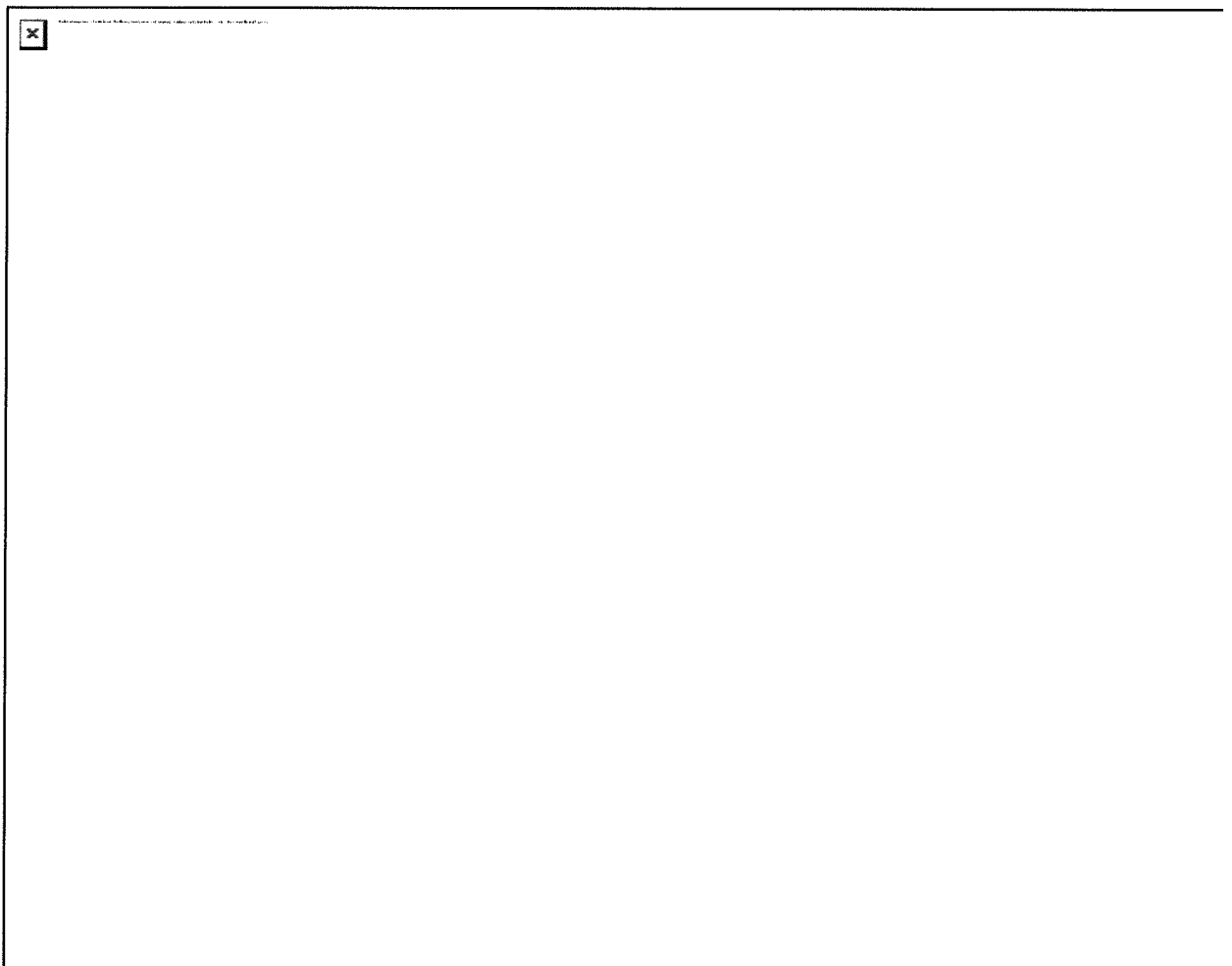
Hello all,

Then the dumpster overflows and we've had rodent issues and neighbors complaining but it's simply an issue with access. I'm wondering which department I can contact to get this resolved. The garbage company of course comes every week but if they can't get down the alley, the dumpster stays full for the next week and overflows.
