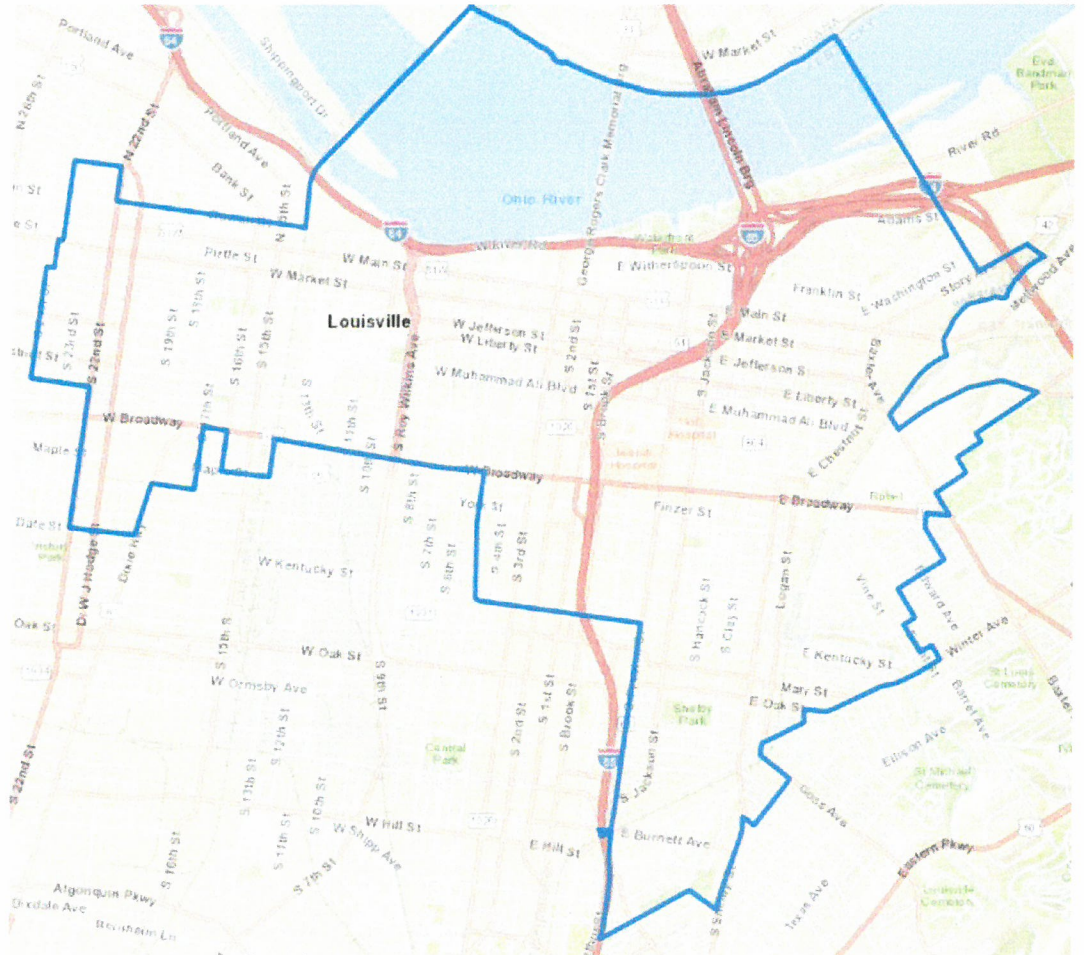

Shalanna,

I transferred to the 1st Division in July of this year and quickly realized we were the only division within LMPD that did not have access to a speed machine. The 1st Division is made up of five different neighborhoods, and as I began attending neighborhood meetings, I noticed an underlying theme: speeding. Every single neighborhood group complained about speeders on their streets. I did research and learned in District 4 alone, there were over 1,500 wrecks

from January 1 to September 30 this year. I requested the speed machine, not only to deter speeders, but also to collect data. The machine compiles a report, documenting the number of vehicles traveled on the street in which it was placed as well as the speeds of those vehicles. This data will be invaluable as we determine when and where to place our resources.
