

Ky. Transportation Cabinet has notified Louisville Metro Parks that federal transportation funds from the Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) have been approved for a Tyler Park/Baxter Ave Bridge engineering study. The study will develop a preservation plan for the bridge, based upon an engineering study. This would include an in-depth structural inspection including measurements for structural load rating, foundation, rehabilitation recommendations with cost estimates, architectural drawings, a review of historical background and significance, and a final report with recommendations.

The 80% federal funds - \$120,000 must be matched with 20% local funds - \$30,000. Thus, we are asking for \$30,000 in CIF funds.

Ky. Governor announces federal funding for study of Tyler Park bridge

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LOUISVILLE, Ky. (WDRB) – Built in 1904, a historic bridge in Louisville is set to be rejuvenated after more than 100 years of wear and tear.

Governor Steve Beshear announced \$120,000 in federal funding to finance a study for the Tyler Park Bridge along Baxter Avenue.

The study will develop a preservation plan.

The bridge has had problems with storm water and sanitary sewer water filtering through the stone structure.

About 11,000 vehicles pass over the bridge every day and allows pedestrians to walk under Baxter Avenue.

The federal money comes from the Transportation Alternatives Program.

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
