The sidewalk and bus stop improvements use Federal Funds and the breakdown is 80% TARC and 20% local Match. I am including some example pdf's of the approvals for other locations. These matching funds would be designated as CIF Funds and managed by Public Works. The cost summary is as follows:

1) Total preliminary project cost = \$68,486.40 (stops #1 - #12)

2) District 7 total preliminary cost = \$38,140.33 (stops #1,#3, #5, & #7)

3) District 7 (20% match) = \$7,628.07
