

I recently read that Representative John Yarmuth is giving a \$1mm grant for sidewalk repairs.

My grandson fell and scraped his knees and legs, people walking by have tripped on the broken sidewalk. On May 2, 2019 I sent a request to Metro 311 to repair the sidewalk in front of my home and no one responded so I went to Twitter this week and asked if my sidewalk could be repaired under this new grant.

I did receive a reply back from Louisville Metro 311 who stated that my request was received May 2, 2019 which was right before they began using a new system and there are **no notes from Public Works**. They requested that I contact Public Works at 502-574-5810 which I did this morning and spoke with Becky. Unfortunately Becky was unable to find my request from May 2019 #5275249-SRV in the new system.

A new service request was input today #SR-SDCB-22-138660. However, this request was sent 3 years ago and I believe that it should be given some priority for repairs. Please let me know what you think and how you may be able to assist in this matter.
