It may also be funded through grants and donations from federal and state governments, corporations, foundations, individuals, and other not-for-profit organizations.

TERM OF APPOINTMENT DETAILS	4 years or until their successor is appointed. May be appointed for one succeeding term. % of initial citizen appointees shall serve for a 2 year term and thereafter will serve a 4 year term. Ex officio members appointment is coterminal with their office or position.
VACANCY APPOINTMENT DETAILS	Mayor appoints a person to serve for the unexpired term.
QUORUM	A majority of membership of COPA shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The affirmative vote of a majority of the members present at a meeting shall be necessary for the adoption of any motion, measure or resolution.
HOW APPOINTED	7 citizens appointed by the Mayor with Council approval
QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS	7 citizen members appointed by Mayor with Council approval: 2 shall be a civic/business leader in Louisville. 1 shall be faculty member of the art department of a university or college in Louisville. 4 shall be professionally involved in visual arts in Louisville.
