

Gina O'Brien and I were catching up this week, and she let me know that she has three older sites that are in jeopardy because they no longer have any maintenance funding. They've been without an active sponsor for at least the past five years. If we can't find a sponsor, we'll have to let them go.

The three sites are below; the first two are very close to one another and almost look like one site, then the third stands alone. Brightside spends \$8,000 annually to collectively maintain the sites; the annual costs per site are noted:

1. Southern Parkway and I-264 = \$2,000
2. Southern Parkway at Southern Heights = \$2,000
3. Poplar Level Road at I-264 = \$4,000

Michelle Black White (Brightside "super" board member) met with Lauren DePaso at Churchill Downs in the summer of 2017 about them potentially taking over the Southern Parkway site. And Brightside also tried to engage Matt Bissell with Churchill Downs to work out an in-kind maintenance exchange in the Fall of 2017. Neither one of those asks were successful.

I have NOT asked Kevin Flanery. I wanted to get your advice/thoughts on whether we should approach CD together about the Southern Pkwy sites? Whether you have other ideas? And do you want me to reach out to Pat M directly on the Poplar Level site?
