

ORDINANCE No. 140, SERIES 2015

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ZONING FROM R-4 SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL, R-7 MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL AND C-1 COMMERCIAL TO C-2 COMMERCIAL AND CHANGING THE FORM DISTRICT FROM NEIGHBORHOOD TO SUBURBAN MARKETPLACE CORRIDOR ON PROPERTY LOCATED AT 3408 BARDSTOWN ROAD CONTAINING 6.5789 ACRES AND BEING IN LOUISVILLE METRO (CASE NO. 15ZONE1008).

WHEREAS, the Council concurs in and adopts the findings of the Planning Commission for the zoning and form district changes in Case No. 15ZONE1008 and approves and accepts the recommendations of the Planning Commission as set out in said minutes and records;

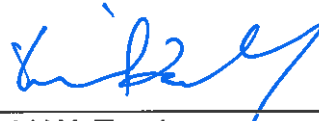
NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

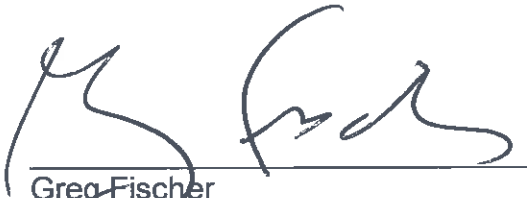
Section I: That the zoning of the property located at 3408 Bardstown Road, containing 6.5789 acres and being in Louisville Metro, as more particularly described in the minutes and records of the Planning Commission in Case No. 15ZONE1008, is hereby changed from R-4 Single Family Residential, R-7 Multi-Family Residential and C-1 Commercial to C-2 Commercial and the form district of the aforesaid property is hereby changed from Neighborhood to Suburban Marketplace Corridor; provided,

however, said property shall be subject to the binding elements as set forth in the minutes of the Planning Commission in Case No. 15ZONE1008.

Section II: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
