

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Councilman James,

Toonerville has been doing a monthly litter cleanup for about a year and we have noticed that the areas that are the worst do not have garbage cans at the intersections like many other places in Old Louisville. Those that do, only have one. Other areas of Old Louisville and elsewhere around the city, it is common to have them on two opposite corners or even one at each corner. Floyd Street does not appear to have any cans at any of the intersections between St Catherine and Hill. We probably need 20 or more cans because we have the largest association by geography and likely the fewest cans in Old Louisville. Can you please help ilia get some cans and for weekly pickup from those cans?
