Do we know width – other than 2" wider. I am just trying to make sure what it takes, because it is more than just concrete depth. I have limited knowledge for engineering but what I do know gets me in trouble or what I think I know at times, because there is a rock base, compaction of this and sometimes different materials are added to concrete pour to give added strength to concrete. I have a staff meeting in AM and will ask these questions but I really do need to get width established so we can figure out cost.
