Dear Mayor Fischer:

The KIPDA Transportation Policy Committee has approved the request from Louisville Metro to use \$1,280,000 of KIPDA's dedicated SLO federal funding to supplement the TIGER funding for the design phase of the "Transforming Dixie" (KYTC Item Number 5-478.7) project. The \$1,280,000 of SLO federal funding requires 20 percent matching funding (\$320,000), and FHWA has indicated to KYTC that it will allow Metro to provide the matching funds as part of the construction phase of the project. Thus, keeping the design of this project 100% federally-funded.

KYTC is in the process of preparing the federal programming document for submittal to FHWA, requesting approval of the \$1,280,000 of dedicated SLO funding for the design phase of the project. Upon FHWA's approval of the federal programming document, KYTC will send the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to Louisville Metro for their approval signatures outlining the usage of the SLO funding for the TIGER project. Recognizing the aggressive TIGER schedule, KYTC hopes that this letter is adequate for Louisville Metro to pass a resolution for its Mayor to sign the agreement from KYTC.
