Last year the amphitheater had 86 events and a total approximate attendance of over 110,000. This summer promises to be bigger and better with more events, more variety and more people!

We would like to request \$22,227.00 to support programming at the Iroquois Amphitheater in the summer of 2018 including: free movies, free and low cost arts events, festivals and any other events organized by Metro Parks and Recreation that serve the Amphitheater's mission to entertain, educate, and enrich our community and to strengthen the arts for future generations of artists and audience.
