Dear Bob,

I am making a request of you in order to solve a problem that faces your weekend guests and your neighbors.

When I “yelled” at Abbey and the driver who nearly hit Tommie Miller as she was exiting her garage on foot, I was upset that Abbey had not advised the driver of the driveway situation and that the driver who was unfamiliar with the driveway use claimed he thought the driveway was an alley. Both Rosemary and I want our privacy and peaceful enjoyment of our property to be respected by your guests who are strangers to us. You can help us with that by opening up access from the front of your house to the rear so that your guests can move freely through your property without having to venture beyond your boundary to get from the front to the rear of their temporary quarters.

If you will have minor modifications made to your gate(s) so that your guests can move freely from the front to the rear of your property you will increase their convenience and you will simultaneously reduce the amount of trespassing that we experience from your guests. We don't like having to take time to address your guests nearly every weekend and I'm sure they don't like being called out by us.

Please let me know whether you accept this suggestion and that you will make modifications to your property to accommodate this request.
