AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ~~\$18,000~~ \$21,000 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$11,000 FROM DISTRICT 15; ~~AND \$7,000 FROM DISTRICT 3;~~ \$1,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 6 AND 21; AND \$500 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 9 AND 14; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO FRIENDS OF NICOLE 50/50 MENTORING COLLABORATIVE, INCORPORATED FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE CRISP WYANDOTTE CAREER READINESS AND BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT (AS AMENDED).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE "COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of ~~\$18,000~~ \$21,000 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$11,000 from District 15; ~~and \$7,000 from District 3;~~ \$1,000 each from Districts 6 and 21; and \$500 each from Districts 9 and 14; through the Office of Management and Budget, to Friends of Nicole 50/50 Mentoring Collaborative, Incorporated for costs associated with the CRISP Wyandotte Career Readiness & Beautification Project.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
