

ORDINANCE NO. 231, SERIES 2017

AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING TO THE CITY OF JEFFERSONTOWN THE PORTION OF BLANKENBAKER ROAD BETWEEN BLANKENBAKER PARKWAY AND DECIMAL DRIVE SO THAT THE RESPONSIBILITY, CONTROL AND MAINTENANCE WILL BE BORNE BY THE CITY OF JEFFERSONTOWN.

WHEREAS, on January 30, 1899, Blankenbaker Road was dedicated to Jefferson County as a 30-foot wide public right-of-way known as road number 255 (see Attachment A), as contained in Minute Order Book 58, pages 242–43 (see Attachment B, transcribed as Attachment C), on record in the Office of the Jefferson County Clerk;

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2003, the Louisville Metro Government, via Ordinance No. 198, Series 2003, created the Louisville Metro Through Road System, an amalgamation of the designated through roads of the former City of Louisville and Jefferson County;

WHEREAS, Blankenbaker Road, a former Jefferson County through road, was designated part of the Louisville Metro Through Road System as CR-1019H and currently runs 1.385 miles from Blankenbaker Parkway (KY 913) to Decimal Drive (CS-1145H) (see Attachment D);

WHEREAS, with the extension of Blanknebaker Parkway, Blankenbaker Road no longer functions as a Louisville Metro Through Road and only provides direct connections to abutting residential and commercial developments within the City of Jeffersontown and direct access to various City of Jeffersontown roads (see Attachment E);

WHEREAS, after a recent annexation, Blankenbaker Road now lies entirely within the incorporated limits of the City of Jeffersontown;

WHEREAS, the City of Jeffersontown has asked Louisville Metro Government to dedicate Blankenbaker Road to the City of Jeffersontown so that the City of Jeffersontown may assume control and maintenance of the public right of-way and relieve Louisville Metro Government thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Louisville Metro Department of Public Works and Assets supports the transfer of the Blankenbaker Road right-of-way to the City of Jeffersontown (see Attachment F).


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The public right-of-way known as Blankenbaker Road and identified as CR-1019H in the Louisville Metro Through Road System is hereby dedicated to the City of Jeffersontown so that the City of Jeffersontown may assume control and maintenance of the public right-of-way and relieve Louisville Metro Government thereof. City of Jeffersontown agrees not to close the road to the public.


SECTION II: This Ordinance shall become effective after: (1) its passage and approval; and (2) passage and approval of an ordinance by the City of Jeffersontown accepting dedication of the right-of-way.

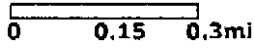
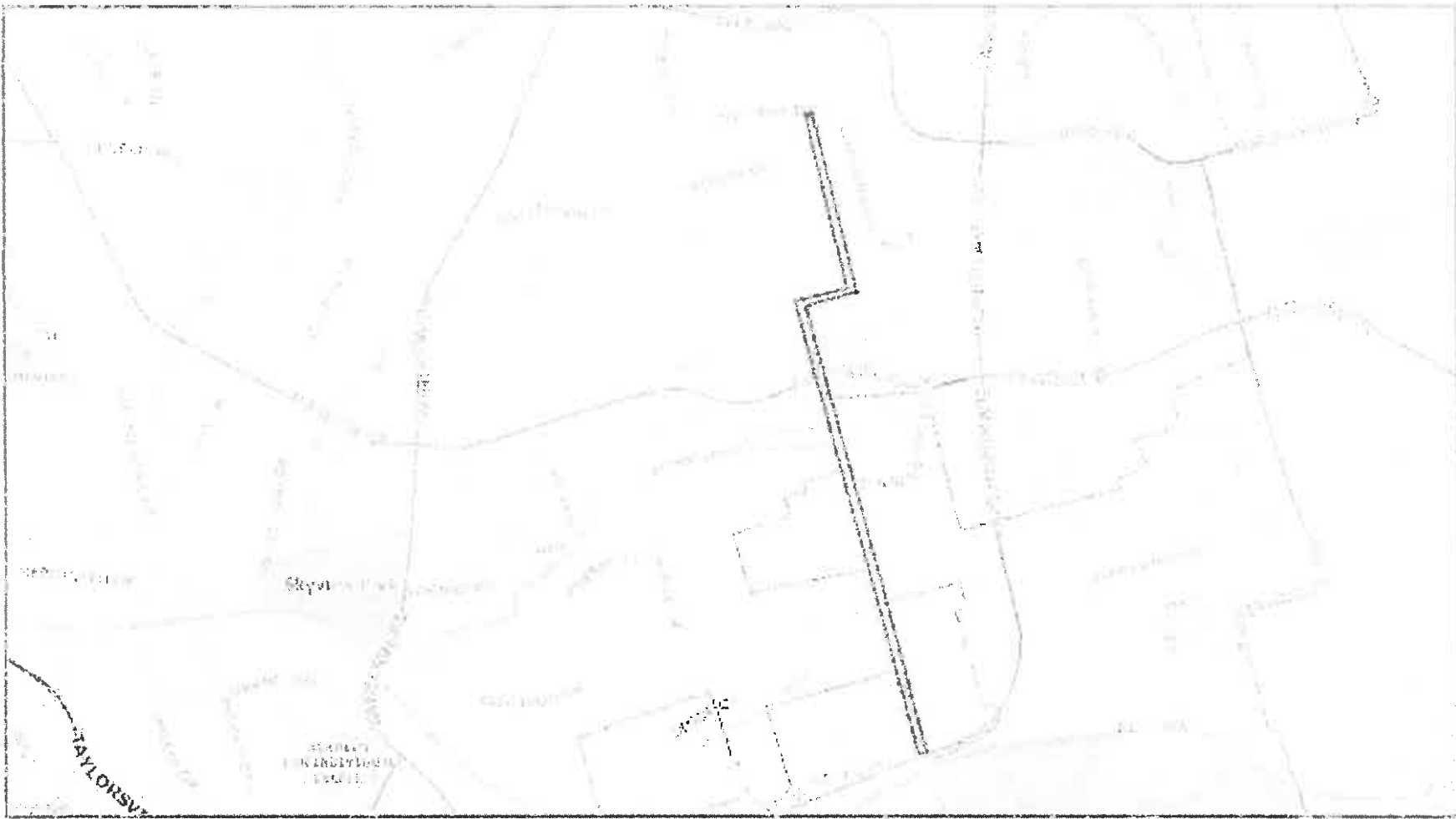
This day came J.T. Gunn and filed herein an agreement signed by John Goose, H.L. Goose, J.T. Blankenbaker, L.A. Blankenbaker, Alice Gunn, Lizzie Goose, Nat Goose, Sallie Goose, J.T. Gunn, Bry Rankin, A. Jones and James Jones, dedicating to Jefferson County, as a County road the tract of land thirty (30) feet in width, as shown by the map filed herein June 24th 1895 said road beginning at a corner to Newkirk and Ellingsworth running thence along the line of Rankin, Elder and Yenowine to H.A. Blankenbaker's corner, thence with H.A. & J.T. Blanknebaker and Rankin to Jones, thence with Jones, thence with Jones, Blankenbaker, and Leonard Goose's heirs to corner to Goose's heir and Kate Snyder, thence with Leonard Goose's heirs and Kate Snyder to John Goose, thence with John Goose and Kate Snyder's line and through John Goose and H.L. Goose's land formerly owned by C.W. Goose to the county road, and it appearing to the Court that all parties in interest have consented to and have joined in said dedication and released said County from any and all claim for damages of any kind by reason of taking of said land for said purpose, or for building of fences, or other damages, it is now considered and adjudged that said road be opened as shown in said map and as dedicated on condition that the petitioners and applicants for said road pay the costs of this procedure and the costs of opening said road and putting the same in condition for travel. J.T. Gunn is hereby authorized, on behalf of the petitioners, to open said roadway, as dedicated, but his compensation, if any, shall be paid by the petitioners.

Public Works supports the transfer in ownership of Blankenbaker Rd (CR-1019H), between Blankenbaker Pkwy (KY 913) and Decimal Dr (CS-1145H), from Louisville Metro County Thru Road to the City of Jeffersontown. With the extension of Blankenbaker Pkwy, Blankenbaker Rd no longer functions as a County Thru Road and only provides direct connections to abutting residential and commercial developments within the City of Jeffersontown and direct access to various City of Jeffersontown roads.

Since this road will remain open and available to the public, no additional engineering or traffic investigation is required to justify this change in ownership. A review of the current roadway network and connectivity provided throughout this area, adequate accommodations for all modes of transportation is being provided.
