The line of sight issue definitely makes sense; Dr. Shanklin is good with doing a hump at the 4911-4912 area, and even an additional one out towards Lively as well. Just let us know how much additional that will be, and Dr. Shanklin should be good with paying for that.

As for Shasta, the reason that CW Shanklin is concerned is that there is a lot of speeding with cars zipping from Unseld onto Shasta and picking up a good amount of speed before they get to the hump near Yaupon. Even though it may seem a bit like overkill, the Councilwoman would be willing to pay for the additional hump anyway, just for the sake of slowing down these individuals.

Thank you for sending this to us Mr. Dow. Dr. Shanklin just had a couple questions:

Is it possible to install an additional speed hump (or two) on Unseld right at the curve and just beyond, where Garden Green Way turns into Unseld Blvd.? This technically may be Garden Green Way at that point, but I believe that the signature pages that we turned in included Garden Green Way addresses as well. If at all possible, Dr. Shanklin would like to make sure that the humps extend at least to 4908 or 4910 Garden Green Way, as one of the biggest speeding issues in the area has been people taking that curve too quickly and ending up in peoples' yards (or worse). I can't install a speed hump on a curve(line of sight issue) but I can place a speed hump in front of addresses 4911-4912 area and on back toward Lively Court.

Additionally, Dr. Shanklin was wondering if an additional speed hump could be installed on Shasta Trail between Unseld Blvd. and Yew Ln. You all installed speed humps on this road last year, but there is no hump all the way from Unseld until Alba, I believe. Dr. Shanklin would like there to be another one added, if at all possible. There should be a speed hump installed on Shasta Trail(Address 4618) between Yaupon Lane and Yew Lane, please see attachment. A speed hump on Shasta Trail between Yew Lane and Unseld Blvd is overkill because you have a stop sign at Shasta Trail and Unseld Blvd.

If these requests are possible, Dr. Shanklin would like to simply add the additional funding to the sum of the current estimates you've just given us, and I will submit a CIF once I have all of the necessary information--that way you all should receive funding for all of these projects all at the same time.

Thank you again, and just let me know if Dr. Shanklin's two requests are feasible; if so, if you wouldn't mind letting me know the additional cost, that would be awesome.
