Ex officio members appointment is coterminous with their office or position.
<b>VACANCY APPOINTMENT DETAILS</b>	Mayor appoints a person to serve for the unexpired term.
<b>QUORUM</b>	A majority of membership of COPA shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The affirmative vote of a majority of the members present at a meeting shall be necessary for the adoption of any motion, measure or resolution.
<b>HOW APPOINTED</b>	7 citizens appointed by the Mayor with Council approval
<b>QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS</b>	7 citizen members appointed by Mayor with Council approval 2 shall be a civic/business leader in Louisville. 1 shall be faculty member of the art department of a university or college in Louisville. 4 shall be professionally involved in visual arts in Louisville.
