To Whom It May Concern: Citation Appeal – Binding Element

I am writing to formally appeal the citation I received, which I believe is unjustified due to the ongoing rezoning process. The claim that the property operates as a junkyard, as noted by the inspector, is inaccurate, as most vehicles present are functioning properly.

Professional Engineer Chris Crumpton is currently working on a landscaping plan for submission and is collaborating with Mark Pinto of the Planning and Design Commission.

The inspector should explain to me exactly which specific aspects fail to meet the required standards established by the plan. I previously filed an appeal regarding a fine under Commission Case Number ENF-ZON-22-000655-18, with the involvement of Steven Bodner. The inspector asked me if I intended to continue working at the site, to which I answered in the affirmative. None of the individuals present made any comment regarding my response. Now, the new inspector assigned to the zone informs me that I cannot continue working at the aforementioned location; he maintains that I am not allowed to work on the site.

It is crucial for me to support my family and address the imposed fine previously. I assure you that the condition of my site is better than that of other workshops in the area. I kindly ask that you reconsider the current fine of \$4,000 as I am unable to operate at full capacity due to the ongoing rezoning process.
