Wanda,

Green Alley between 19th and 20th St (parallel to Jefferson and Cedar St) is a brick paver alley. If you want to maintain it as Brick pavers, the best estimate I can give you \$500/SY. The roadway is 650 ft by 12 ft wide, so I estimate to replace brick pavers to be \$430,000.00.

The area is in a historic district but not a preservation district, so in-lieu of replacing all of the brick pavers, these could potentially be removed and replaced with asphalt pavement. For us to do this, I assume the worst that 12 inches will need to be excavated to install a new pavement section which is in line with our alley standards. I estimate to repave the alley will cost \$47,500.00. This includes replacement of 4 ramps as well. This estimate does not include repaving of Green Alley Cir. I copied Savannah Darr to ensure that we would be okay to remove the brick pavers and replace with asphalt.

Please advise of the limits in which you want Plymouth Ct and Coke St estimated for. Both extend for multiple blocks.
