**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$14,000 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$10,000 FROM DISTRICT 1 NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS; AND \$1,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 10, 12, 13, AND 15; TO LOUISVILLE METRO POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE VICTIM SERVICES UNIT WHICH PROVIDES EMERGENCY SHELTER AND RELOCATION ASSISTANCE TO A CRIME VICTIM OR WITNESS (AS AMENDED).**

**SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBERS GREEN, MULVIHILL, BLACKWELL, FOX, AND TRIPLETT**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (“THE COUNCIL”) AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The sum of \$14,000 in Neighborhood Development Funds is hereby appropriated in the following manner: \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from District 1; Neighborhood Development Funds and \$1,000 each from Districts 10, 12, 13, and 15; to Louisville Metro Police Department to provide funding for the Victim Services Unit which provides emergency shelter and relocation assistance to a crime victim or witness.

**SECTION II:** The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

**SECTION III:** This grant is subject to the Council’s Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

**SECTION IV:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
