LFD Overview

- **467** Personnel, **409** Emergency Medical Technicians; **13** Paramedics
- **43** New Recruits in Hiring Process
- **200** Hazardous Materials technicians
- Largest Bureau: **Fire Suppression/Operations**
- **21 Fire Stations**
- **27 Fire Companies** (Fire Apparatus with Crew)
- Divided into **Four (4) Districts or Battalions**
- Suppression Personnel work a **24 Hour shift**, followed by 48 hours off


