I have completed the cost estimate for this project. Because Frankfort Ave is owned and maintained by KYTC we will have to request approval from them to do this. During the field inspection it was noticed there is a marked parking space pretty close to the alley next to First National Bank. It would have to be removed for this project. The cost to grind out the last parking space and install (1) thermo triangular section with hatching to restrict parking is \$1,000 (on the same block face as Blue Dog Bakery). It will be three to four months until we can get to it. We are pretty behind right now so please let us know if you want to move forward with it so we can go ahead and schedule it while you are working to secure the funding.

Bill - I'm writing you as the manager of the First Financial Bank in Crescent Hill. My issue is with the street parking that borders the ally to our parking lot and drive thru. On the south side of the street (bank side) there is a "no parking past>" sign that is not visible and there is no paint on the curb to indicate "no parking". Cars park there very very regularly and it makes it impossible to see westbound traffic (especially an SUV)- its only a matter of time before there is a major accident. Could you come take a look and see if it is possible to create the appropriate traffic tools to keep that corner empty? Thanks,

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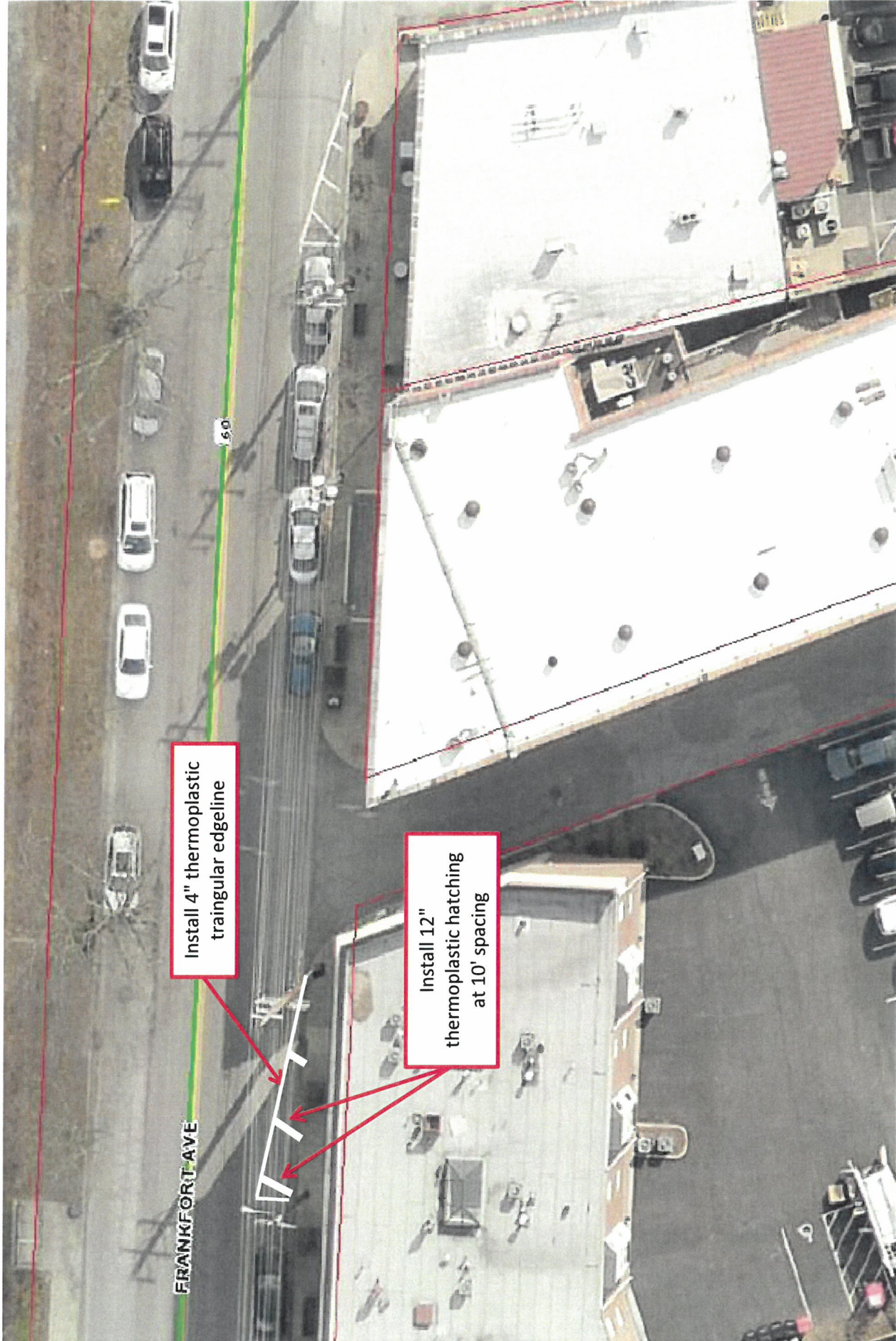
