Caleb,

I am checking on status of Lagoona Dr with the contractor to see when it is scheduled. I have no idea what you are referring to with Samara Dr. Is this a CIF request? I have not seen anything on it.

I sent the estimates on Delaware and Monticello on 5/29/19 and consider these estimates still valid. If these projects are funded the best timeline I can provide right now for repaving would be spring 2020. We have a few weeks of ramp work to complete prior to paving, so I would suggest that the CIF request be sent to public works ASAP so we can hopefully work it in during the winter months to be one of the first projects repaved in the spring.

Councilwoman Shanklin,

I performed a desktop review of the local roadways discussed yesterday consisting of Delaware Dr, Monticello Ave, Allen Ave, Gathwright Dr, Shelton Ave, and Pruitt Ct. I am finding that the roadways all have a consistent level of distress which show moderate to severe cracking where I believe minor base failure reconstruction is going to be necessary. In addition to this, all roadways have sidewalks which will require those ramps to be updated to meet ADA standards. Finally, there are several locations within this area where roll curbs appear to have settled and causing some water to stand and debris to build up. I estimate that the following costs for repaving of each roadway within the area:

Delaware Dr \$85,000.00
Monticello Ave: \$75,000.00
Allen Ave: \$15,000.00
Gathwright Dr: \$62,500.00
Shelton Ave: \$13,500.00
Pruitt Ct: \$47,500.00

Rural Way appears to be in a similar condition as those noted above but from what I see on Google, sections of the roll curb appear to have been previously paved into. Those sections which have not had asphalt placed in the roll curb appear to be in fairly decent condition. I am proposing that we remove the asphalt from the curb, and then repave back into the curb as necessary (most likely just in the locations where asphalt was already placed into the curbs). Sidewalk ramps will also need to be updated as part of this project. I estimate this Rural Way from Shepherdsville Rd to Rustic Way to cost \$125,000.00 to repave.

In addition to Rural Way, I wanted to bring to your attention that LWC recently completed a main replacement project on Rustic Way, Ripple Way, and Brenda Dr. As part of their project, they mainly only impacted intersections, but did extend into the roadway within a few locations which will need to be restored. If you have any additional funds, it may be a good idea to supplement funding to extend

paving limits of those roadways. If this is something you would be interested in, I can provide more detailed cost estimates for you.
