

ORDINANCE NO. 003, SERIES 2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 102, SERIES 2016 RELATING TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-17 CAPITAL BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING \$425,000 TO EMERGENCY SERVICES' EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY RELATED TO RELOCATION AND PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT ASSOCIATED WITH 1300 AND 1306 BARDSTOWN ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION II: Part I., F. EMERGENCY SERVICES, of Ordinance No. 102, Series 2016, is hereby amended as follows:




SECTION III: The Council has determined the funds requested in this ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.
