- West End Opportunity Partnership TIF

Allowing TIFs for projects that would not go forward without an approved TIF, and applying this standard to an area that already has significant development
How TIF financing can be used to redevelop areas, especially when a large box store leaves and the property remains vacant

- How TIFs impact what is nearby

- Passing TIFs for no more than 1,000 acres - Laws on TIFs

- Total amount of tax revenue on hold due to TIFs

- When all TIFs would be finished if no others were approved

- Churchill Downs TIF, and the tax savings is not capped for this TIF and

Louisville gets 0 percent of the incremental revenue

- Whether future development for Churchill Downs is covered by their TIF

- How much of the \$1.5B would come to Louisville if there were no TIFs
