ORDINANCE NO. 200, SERIES 2021

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$8,500 \$11,500 \$13,000 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$5,000 FROM DISTRICT 12; \$1,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 10, 13, 14, 15, 21, 24, AND 25; AND \$500 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 17 AND 22; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO HARBOR HOUSE OF LOUISVILLE, INC. TO ASSIST WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE INTERGENERATIONAL LIFE CENTER (AS AMENDED).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$8,500 \$11,500 \$13,000 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$5,000 from District 12; \$1,000 each from Districts 10, 13, 14, 15, 21, 24, and 25; and \$500 each from Districts 17 and 22; through the Office of Management and Budget, to Harbor House of Louisville, Inc. to assist with the construction of the Intergenerational Life Center.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and

approval.
